Dr. Thomas Kouo

Dr. Kouo currently serves as the Dean at the Eastern School of Acupuncture and Traditional Medicine in Bloomfield, New Jersey and is an instructor in several Doctoral programs across the country. He has served as a long-time site visitor for ACAHM (formerly ACAOM).

Elected to Vice-President of the Council after a six-year term as an At-large member of the Executive Committee, Dr. Kouo is the past chair of the CCAHM Herb Committee and currently serves as the co-chair for the School Clinic Committee.
