Mr. Millison currently serves as the Academic Dean for the Virginia University of Integrative Medicine and has done so since 2018.

Prior to arriving at VUIM, Jeff was the Academic Director of the Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine department at the Maryland University of Integrative Health from 2001-2018. A faculty member at that institution since 1992, he also served as a clinical supervisor and taught multiple courses.

Mr. Millison is the Chair of the CCAHM Curriculum Committee, and was a member of the ACAHM (Accreditation Commission of Acupuncture and Herbal Medicine) First Professional Doctorate Task Force. In addition, he has served as a Site Visitor for ACAHM as well as other accreditation commissions.
